

# SnapWords™

## Not just your basic sight words.



*A snap for the teacher, a cinch for the child.*

Talk about the SnapWords™ like you would pictures in a story book. The images will be stored in memory along with the word, making for easy recall.

Use the sentence and the body motion provided. When the children can instantly recognize the stylized words, turn the cards over and check their knowledge with the plain words. Set aside the words they don't recognize on sight and use the stylized side again.

**Embedded image** shows meaning of the word, aids in comprehension

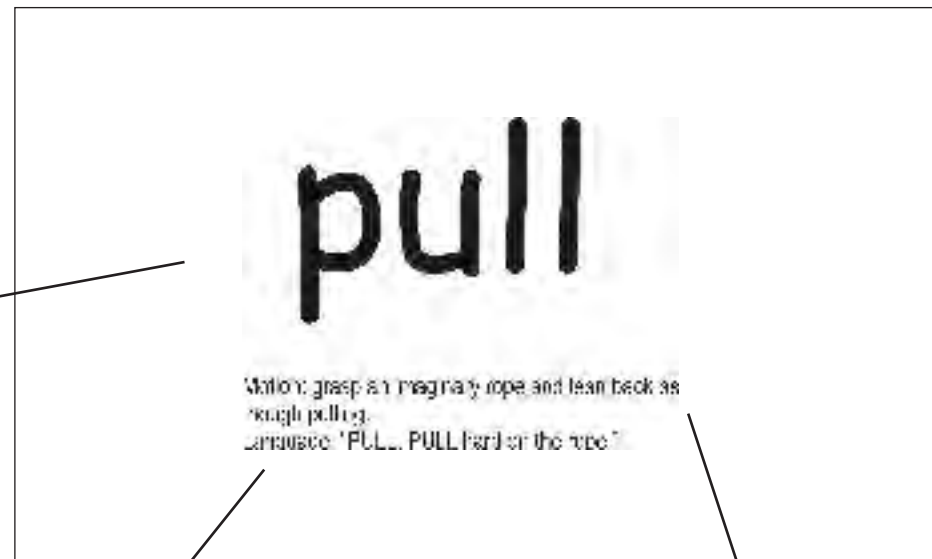
**Colorful visuals** attract children to learning

**Implied story or scene** engages children as they recall their own experiences with tug of war

**Visuals** ease learning for English language learners

**Plain word** on the reverse provides a quick assessment of word recognition

**Sentence** uses word in context showing correct usage of the word



**Body motion** provides another avenue to the brain - critical to kinesthetic learners
